RESOLUTION TO UTILIZE CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS FOR PLANNING ASSOCIATED WITH WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, \$36,401.06 has been allocated to the City of Canton in recovery funds through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA);

WHEREAS, the ARPA provides funds to state, local, and tribal governments to make necessary investments in water and wastewater infrastructure;

WHEREAS, Congress recognizes the critical role that clean drinking water and services for the collection and treatment of wastewater play in protecting public health;

WHEREAS, eligible uses of ARPA funds align with the wide range of types or categories of projects that would be eligible to receive financial assistance through the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) or Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF);

WHEREAS, City staff and the City's attorney have reviewed CWSRF and DWSRF project eligibility requirements as outlined by the EPA;


WHEREAS, eligible projects include planning and design; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered an engineer agreement to develop a preliminary engineering report of the present water and wastewater systems.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City intends to utilize ARPA funds to cover expenses associated with the water and wastewater systems preliminary engineering report, including televising the sanitary sewer system.
2. The City will comply with all reporting requirements for ARPA fund expenditures.
