#### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND PARCEL ID 09.0195.020

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canton has received from the County of Fillmore a non-conservation forfeited property listing that includes Parcel ID 09.0195.020 in said City, which became property of the State of Minnesota for non-payment of real estate taxes, and;

**WHEREAS**, the previous fee owner, Steven W. Popplewell, accumulated \$7,148.79 in outstanding taxes, and;

**WHEREAS**, provided in Minnesota Statute 282, the City Council determines the disposal of this parcel of land, located at 200 North Oak Street, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City can approve the parcel for public auction, or approve the parcel sale to adjacent landowners, or request conveyance to the City for public use, without monetary consideration, and;


**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Marc Prestby, representing the Fifth District, set the basic sale price at \$1.00, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Fillmore County approved the basic sale price at \$1.00.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Canton does request the Board of Fillmore County to approve the disposal of this parcel in the following way:

1. Parcel to be offered for public auction, with no pending special assessments.
